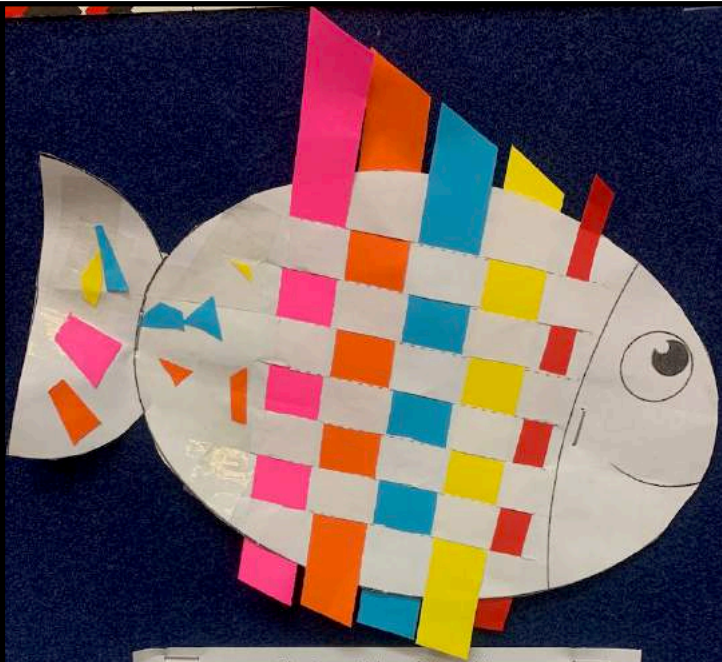

### **UKULELE**

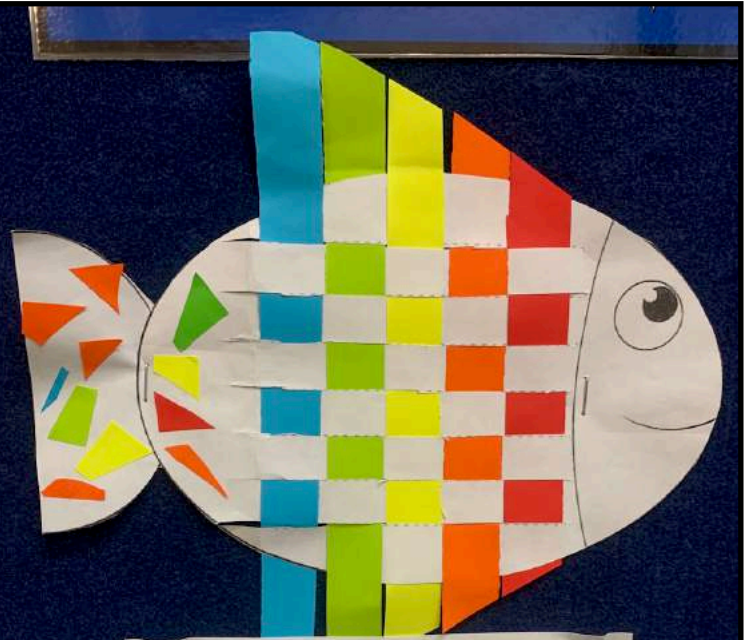
Unfortunately Ukulele John is unavailable this term so there will be no ukulele lessons available. We are hoping he will be back on board next term.

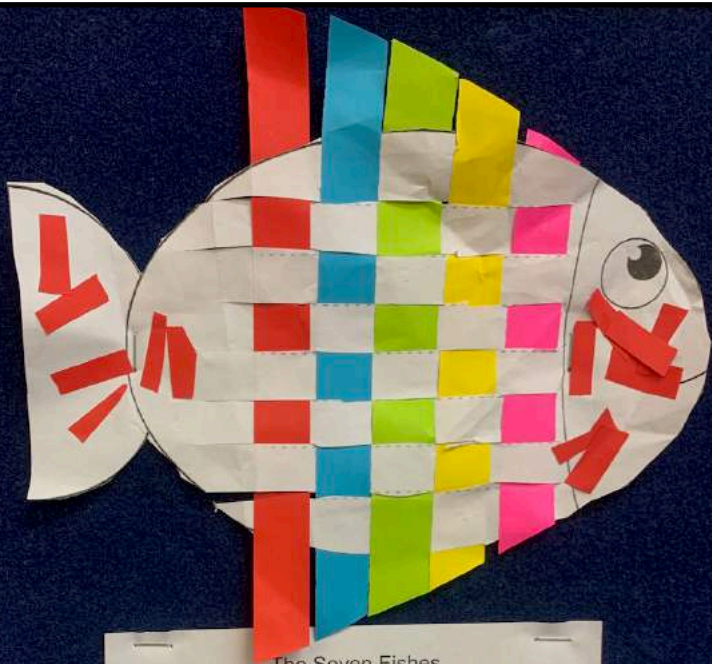
