Ear Clinic

The free mobile ear and hearing testing service will be at Morrinsville School, Lincoln Street, **Thursday 12th August 12:30pm till 2:30pm**. There is a trained ear nurse available at the Caravan. The service includes assessment of children in all aspects of ear infection treatment; grommet checks; cleaning of running ear; safe removal of wax and foreign bodies. No appointment is necessary. A parent or caregiver must attend with children.
