## Manaakitanga Kindness



New Zealand has moved to the new Covid Protection Framework (Traffic Light system) on Friday last.

New Zealand Schools may continue to operate under the Alert Level 2 system for on-site **curriculum** events that involve students and staff only.

For any **non-curriculum** activities, e.g. prizegiving or Assembly, involving parents/whānau, we are required to operate under the new Covid Protection Framework. Therefore the rules around prizegiving will be:

1. Parents/whānau may attend but you will be required to present your My Vaccine Pass at the school gate. This applies to any persons over the age of 12 years 3 months.
2. Entry will only be through the main gate (Lincoln Street opposite office).
3. The use of masks is encouraged.

A notice with further details will be sent home later in the week.



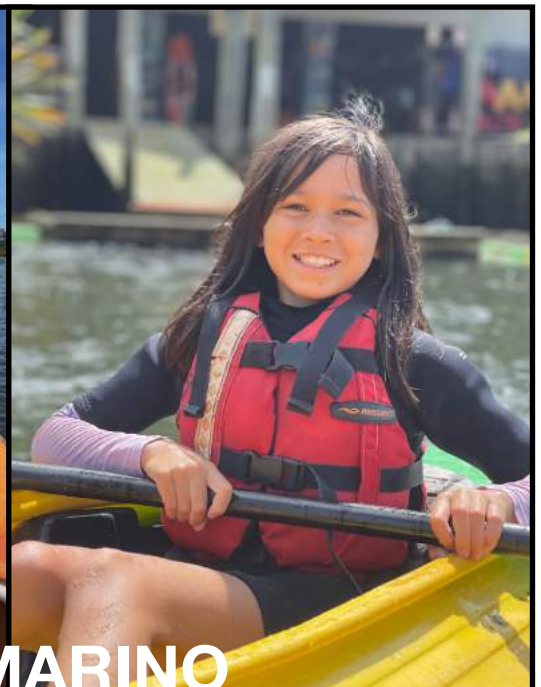
