Orange Phase

For the start of Term 3 2022 the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health have strongly recommended for the first four weeks of term that all Yrs 4-8 students wear masks in all indoor settings (where it will not have a significant impact on teaching and learning, e.g. eating and drinking). There is no requirement for masks to be worn in Yrs 1-3 but anyone who chooses to will be supported. Face masks are one of the key health measures to help slow the spread of Covid indoor settings. Child-sized masks are available for students or you may bring your own.

All classrooms will observe the other health requirements such as regular hand washing and sanitising.
