School Attendance

We continue to push for more improvement in levels of attendance. Last week we had a number of classes which had a "full house", that is all children on the classroom roll were present e.g. Room 5 (Year 7/8) had a "full house" on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday - an excellent achievement! For the week the top classroom attendance levels were: Room's 2 & 5 had a 96% rate. Room 3 had 95% attendance. Room 12 had 94% and Room 4 had 91%. Room 7 had 81% which was our lowest.
