Again I'd like acknowledge and thank families for heeding our request to have children attending school every day. Teachers are aware of occasions when children miss a day. However when children miss 1 day or 2 days a week then the school has to follow up and support the family change this pattern. The Ministry of Education (local office) is playing a greater role in identifying patterns of non attendance and requiring schools to “explain” how schools are addressing this problem. Our attendance goal remains 90%+ per pupil, per week.
