We will join in a Poowhiri to welcome us onto the Marae and our tamariki will learn about the history of the Marae and its surrounding area.

We will travel to Kai-a-te-Mata via bus and will return before the end of the school day. All children are to bring their morning tea and lunch will be provided as usual.

As part of our school we follow the tikanga (Marae protocol) of Ngaati Haaua, therefore we will be laying a koha during the Poowhiri. We request that each child/whaanau contributes a koha (donation) towards our school's koha.
