SOCCER HOCKEY FUNDAY



This Thursday 14th September (Postponement date Friday 15th September), <u>ALL</u> children from Rooms 1, 2, 3, and 4 and some from Room 5, 11 & 12 will be participating in the Soccer/Hockey Fun Day at the Morrinsville Recreation Grounds with other local schools.
