Bookings will be open on 28 May 2024.

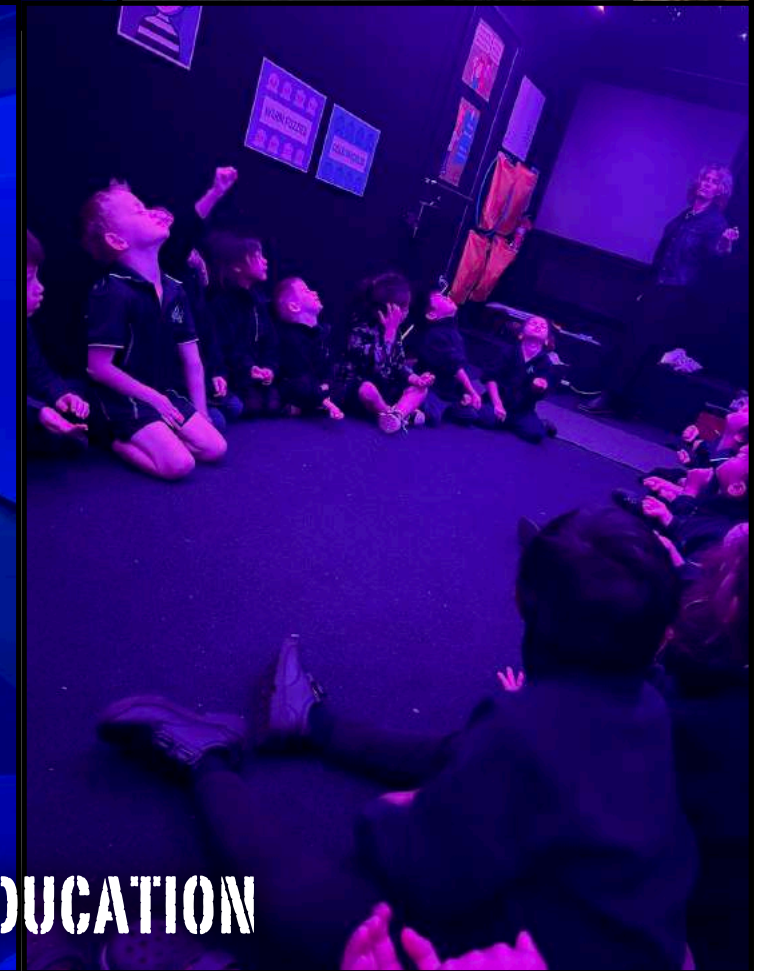
