Ka Ora, Ka Ako Healthy School Lunches Programme

Our lunch supplier, Bite Lab, provide hot healthy nutritious lunches daily.

We encourage all children to participate in the Healthy School lunch programme. Children are to participate in the programme every day and cannot pick and choose which day they wish to participate.

Our school lunches are intended to provide children with food that is nutritional for them and which will, overtime, get them to know a variety of wholesome foods.

The school's expectation of parents whose children opt out of the lunch programme is that they are provided with a nutritional and wholesome lunch.

Children who are not participating in the Healthy School lunch programme are not to bring snack food to school for lunch. Children do enjoy the small occasional treat in their lunchboxes which we don't worry about.

We definitely want the children eating well as there is a strong research connection between children consuming nutritional food and their concentration and learning.

Another note is that we are a 'water only' school. Juice, fizzy drinks, jelly and Up and Go are prohibited at school.
