- Don't forget to brush your hair and teeth and bring a **BIG** smile.



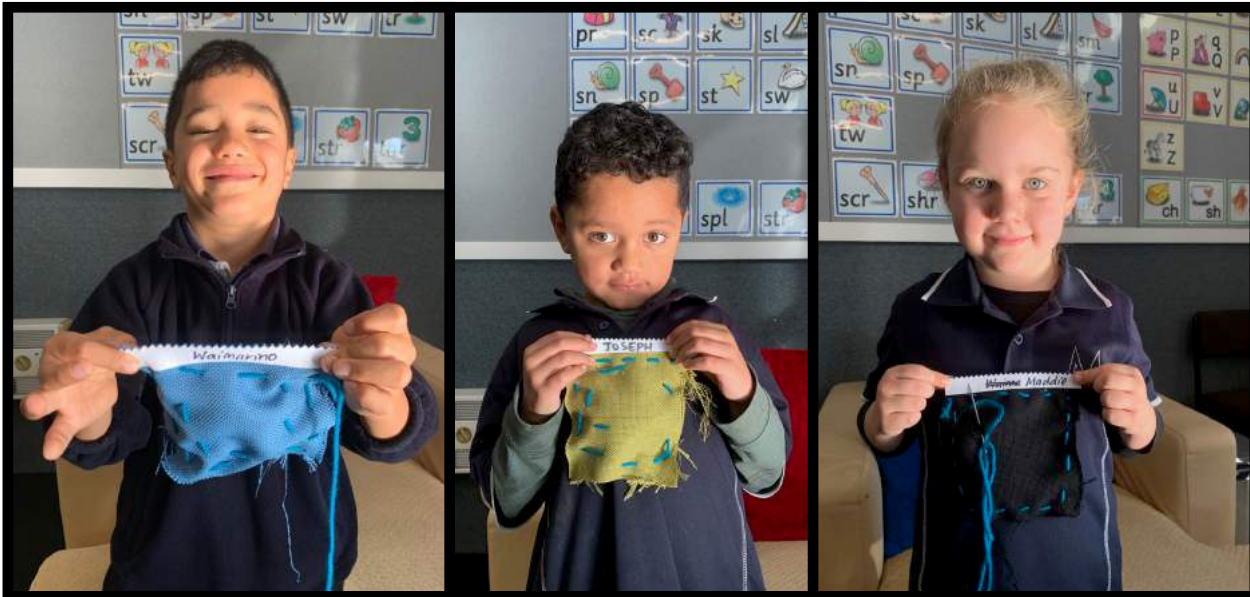
SCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY
